The American writer and activist Elizabeth Cady Stanton was a trailblazer in the women's rights movement in the United States.

The 19th Amendment, granting women the right to vote, was introduced to Congress in 1878 and certified 42 years later in 1920. It is typically celebrated on August 18 —

the anniversary of when Tennessee ratified the Amendment.

In honor of the passing of the 19th amendment, Mary Louise Bianco will portray and discuss Elizabeth's life and the First Women's Rights Convention in Seneca Falls, NY, held July 19-20 in 1848.
